Call to Order: Deb Zimmerman called the March 17, 2020 meeting of the Walker Township Parks & Rec Board to order at 6:00pm in the Walker Township Municipal Building. Deb led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance. Cindy Kunes motioned to approve the minutes from the February 18, 2020 Meeting as presented; motion second by Patty Corell and approved by all members present.

Guests: Ryan Miller updated the Board on his Eagle Scout to move and update the volleyball court. He researched equipment needed and different options for the court borders. Pam Rogers motioned to purchase the poles, if possible without the padding, and the border materials as recommended; motion second by Jan McDowell and approved by all members present. The Board asked Ryan to provide the Board with a total cost estimate for final approval of the project at the April Meeting.

Agenda Items: Discussion on developing the new parkland was tabled.

Old Business:

- Cindy reported the NVJRA canceled their March meeting.
- A Facility Use Agreement was provided to the Nittany Valley Little League. Deb reported the Little League was working to remove the score box and storage shed but they lacked the manpower to complete the projects and asked for assistance from the Township. Supervisor Harter replied that it was Little Leagues responsibility and requested the Board notify Little League and set a time line for their removal. Deb will draft a letter to Little League. Nittany Valley Little League returned a signed Agreement. The Board will request the Township to put caution tape around the two structures.
- The Easter Egg Hunt will be rescheduled due to the COVID-19 Pandemic.

New Business:

- Deb reported she was contacted regarding the use of the park during the state mandated shutdown. She contacted neighboring municipalities for guidance and the Board agreed that the park would remain open. However, the use of the ball fields would not be available for group organized activities and state guidelines must be followed.
- The Board recommended Fee-in-Lieu of zero for the David & Patricia Zerby Subdivision (CCPDCO 8-20) as there is already a dwelling unit on the additional lot.
