Call to Order: Deb Zimmerman called the June 20, 2017 meeting of the Walker Township Park & Rec Board to order at 6:00pm in the Walker Township Municipal Building. Deb led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance. Pam Rogers motioned to approve the minutes from the May 23, 2017 meeting as presented; motion second by Cindy Kunes and approved by all members present.

Agenda Items: There were no Agenda Items.

Guests: There were no guests present.

Old Business:

- Deb Zimmerman had nothing further to report on completion of the ‘Wall of Appreciation’.
- Electrical service is installed in the new pavilion and the picnic tables will be delivered next week. There is some clean up work to be completed and the broken water line has been repaired.
- Deb reported the Supervisors approved the design of new sign at the Rt 64 park entrance. She will place the order.
- Deb met with Mitchell Holden regarding the tree marker stones and will place the order when all the donor information is received.
- Bids for resurfacing the walking trail were opened at the June 7th Supervisors Meeting. All bids were rejected and the Supervisors will re-bid the project along with the bid for resurfacing the back parking lot. Bids will be opened at the July Supervisors meeting.

New Business:

- Approval was given to a request from Eli Halterman to use our park basketball courts for the Centre Regions Park & Rec “Growing the Game” youth basketball summer league. He is requesting use of the courts on Sunday from 4-6pm from June 4th through July 30. The kids he coaches are from the Bellefonte Area. Deb will post a sign at the courts.
- Fee-in-Lieu payment was received for the Leslie Deitrich 2-Lot Subdivision.
- Deb reported on discussion at the June Supervisors Meeting regarding the Park & Rec Board budget. It was agreed that Park & Rec in the future will specify what account expenses should be paid from. There was also discussion of combining the three Park & Rec accounts into one for easier accountability.

- Cindy Kunes reported the Supervisors will allow her to serve on both the Planning Commission and the Park & Rec Board. Planning Commission suggested she choose only one in order to allow other Township residents the opportunity to serve.
- Deb reported Bill Workman contacted her regarding landscaping work he did at the Eagle Scout Project and the Quiet Area. Deb and Bill discussed ideas for displaying the concrete plaques at the Quiet Area. Bill suggested mounting them in metal frames. The Board will look into different options for displaying them.

Patty Correll provided information and registration forms for the Fall Festival scheduled for September 23. The Board discussed the festival plans at length.
