Call to Order: Deb Zimmerman called the June 21, 2016 meeting of the Walker Township Park & Rec Board to order at 6:00pm in the Walker Township Municipal Building. Deb led the group in the Pledge of Allegiance. Pam Rogers motioned to approve the minutes from the May 17, 2016 meeting as presented; motion second by Patty Correll and approved by all members present.

Agenda Items: There were no Agenda Items.

Guests: There were no Guests present.

Old Business:

- Deb has not yet received a quote for the Park Rules signs;
- There was nothing further to report on completion of the ‘Wall of Appreciation’;
- The newly constructed restroom is open for use. The Supervisors met with the Contractor last week to discuss some problems that need to be corrected;
- Construction of the pavilion will begin soon. Township personnel will do some of the work;
- Patty reported she continues to receive inquiries and distribute forms for potential participants for the Fall Festival. Payment for booth space should be made to Walker Township. Walker Township History Books will be available for purchase.
- Deb reported Mitchell Holden has sold four benches and seven trees for in the Park as his Eagle Scout Project. Mitchell scheduled a work date for June 25th to install benches and plant trees. The Board discussed the need to purchase additional benches for this project. Cheryl Vonada motioned to purchase four additional benches; motion second by Patty Correll and approved by all members present. Deb will respond to an inquiry regarding a tree purchase;
- Deb met with Bill Workman regarding updating the landscaping at the Quiet Area. The bushes are overgrown and are blocking the spotlights on the flag and some of the plantings need replaced. Deb also met with a concrete contractor to discuss replacing the stone walkway. The Board will meet at the Quiet Area following adjournment of tonight’s meeting to assess the area;
- Bill Workman continues to do landscaping work at the Eagle Scout Project at the rear of the Park. He has agreed to mow the area also;
- The wooden sign at the entrance to the park needs replaced. Deb Zimmerman motioned to purchase a new sign; motion second by Cindy Kunes and approved by all members

present. Deb will contact the Supervisors regarding what type of replacement sign they prefer. The Board also discussed the need to add lighting to the sign to improve visibility to the entrance;

New Business:

- The Board reviewed the Final Plan of the Christopher Sanders Subdivision to Replot Lot 1 into Lots 1R, 7, 8 and 9 (CCPCDP File No 81-16) creating four new residential Lots for his property located on Zion Back Road. The Board approved recommending 'Fee-in-Lieu' of \$2,500.00 each for four residential lots for total assessment of \$10,000.00
